PRIVACY POLICY

Ensuring a comprehensive security and extensive data protection is much more than just an obligation to observe the statutory and regulatory requirements. It is also a clear testimony of the quality of our services to our customers and employees alike. That is why Deutsche Telekom Group, of which T-Mobile Polska S.A. is a member, has implemented personal data and privacy protection standards that apply to all affiliated companies. T-Mobile Polska S.A., administrator of the www.t-mobile.pl web portal does not use www.t-mobile.pl to collect personal data of its users.

The www.t-mobile.pl web portal uses “cookies” to store certain information about its users and their preferences. However, they are not used for processing or storing personal data, but only for storing information that allows to:

adjust the website to the needs of its users;

generate viewing statistics for individual pages within the portal;

customize selected information displayed within the portal and on partner pages according to the user's interests.

Users who do not wish for “cookies” to be used as detailed above can prevent “cookies” from being stored on their hard drives by disabling the feature in their browsers. Cookies can also be deleted manually at any time. Detailed instructions can be found on your browser manufacturer's website.

T-Mobile Polska S.A. fully respects the right to privacy and protection of process data. T-Mobile Polska S.A. collects information on the use of this portal only by storing process data, such as date of connection with the service and IP address, into system logs. Such information is used for administrative and statistical purposes only and does not enable identification of individual users.

The data are stored in a special security zone and can only be accessed by authorized persons connected with www.t-mobile.pl and bound by confidentiality rules. According to art. 18(6) of the Act on the Electronic Provision of Services dated 18 July 2002 (Journal of Laws, issue 144, item 1204), T-

Mobile Polska S.A. may be obliged to disclose information included in access logs (especially including IP number of the computer) to the authorities entitled thereto by law, for the purpose of their proceedings.
